RFID credentials

Dexterity and memory care no longer have to be a challenge. All Kaba lock applications recommended for assisted living communities feature contactless technology. Through the convenience of radio frequency identification (RFID) technology, access information is relayed between the credential and lock via contactless communication. Users merely present their RFID credentials to the lock reader to operate the lock. This single-motion ease of operation is especially beneficial for residents with limited dexterity.

Common RFID electronic locking features include:

- Stand-alone battery-operated locks and operating system
- Contactless read/write technology - credential communicates with lock via RFID waves and does not require a physical contact point
- Automatic cancellation of previous credential to eliminate lost or stolen key issues
- System transaction history generated by operating system
- ADA-compliant levers
- A single credential can be used to access multiple areas
- Multiple authorization levels control access for staff, vendors, and visitors
- Credentials work continuously and only expire at specifically programmed times or when cancelled by operating system
- Audit trail stored in lock
- Multiple credential types available - keys, keycards, wristbands, and fobs
- Credentials do not demagnetize

SAM RF™ is a Windows-based program that features point-and-click functionality. A complete SAM RF system includes the software, the key encoder, and the RFID key. The RF key encoder is a station that comprises a key encoder and utility device.

- System identifies key type, user, and issue/expiration date for smart, memory, and MIFARE keycards
- Controls multiple properties from a single database and networks various communities
- Variety of reports available: transaction history, key-user history, keys made, limited-use audits, and lock audits
- RF key is impervious to moisture
- RF key can operate private residence locks as well as common access area locks
- Unit and suite locks (residence locks) store up to 200 entries
- Common access locks designed for high-traffic areas store up to 2000 entries

System 6000™:

System 6000™ is a Windows-based system that provides the security of an access audit system and superior control across your community. It is menu-driven to ensure fast and easy operation with software changes that are readily available when new updates become available. System 6000 is at the heart of two SAFLOK contactless RFID locks: MT™ RFID and Quantum™ RFID.



Messenger™:

Messenger™ is a bi-directional wireless locking system and is available using infrared (IR) or radio-frequency (RF) technologies.

- Enables communication with a lock without visiting the door
- Remotely performs the same functions as a handheld programmer, including lock interrogation and diagnostics
- Staff can perform a remote change in access authorization within seconds if a key is lost or stolen
- Can perform remote simultaneous reconfiguration of access authorization of all locks in the event of lost Master key
- Sends low-battery indication or door-ajar messages to a central server
- Gives staff real-time information for added security and smooth operations



MT™ RFID:

- Full-body design covers holes left by other locks in retrofit applications
- Optional mechanical key override available for MT™ RFID
- LED lights displayed behind high impact polycarbonate lens
- Optional automatic deadbolt
- Available in mortise version only
